Signing of the Partnership Agreement within the "Fireshield" project

Within the Cross-Border Cooperation Program of the European Union, North Macedonia – Albania (IPA II) financed by the CROSS BORDER FIRESHIELD project, three municipalities from North Macedonia and Albania will develop and put into practice a joint management plan risk for fire protection, where the Municipality of Vrapçisht and the Municipality of Bogovina, according to the Law on inter-municipal cooperation, will establish a joint department for fire protection. On Friday, March 4, 2022, the initial meeting of the project was held in the premises of the Municipality of Vrapçisht, during which representatives from each beneficiary of the project, including Mr. Isen Shabani, the mayor of the municipality of Vrapçisht, Mr. Mr. Besnik Emshi Mayor of Bogovina Municipality and Sister Camilla Maenza from CARITAS South of Albania together with the project management team had the introductory presentation of the partner and the presentation of the project summary.

As part of the initial meeting, the beneficiaries of the project signed a Partnership Agreement and decided on the composition of the Steering Committee of the project. The FIRESHIELD project manager and project coordinators presented the Project Implementation Plan and discussed the initial steps for the preparation of the project's Communication Plan.

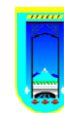
